

Hudson

Hudson is a six-row winter barley developed at Cornell University in New York. Hudson is one of the most winter-hardy varieties that has been tested in Washington. The variety has small heads and matures early. It has taller and weaker straw than Luther.

Hudson has not been recommended because the yields have not been as high as Luther in tests conducted by Washington State University. Hudson has potential and is being used extensively in the winter barley breeding program at Washington State University.

Hudson is a true winter barley and requires cold weather for seed set.
