

KLAGES MALTING BARLEY is now the standard of malting varieties. Klages is a two-row variety adapted to irrigation. Klages has stiff straw and is mid-season in maturity. Klages was developed in Idaho but it does not yield as well as Vanguard or Piroline, other malting varieties. Premiums for malting barley help offset lower yields.

GRAIN STORAGE measurement in cylindrical shaped containers is determined by calculating cubic feet: C. F. = radius squared x 3.1416 x height of grain. C. F. x 0.8 = bushels of grain
