

OAT VARIETIES

Cayuse is a new, moderately-early oat with short, stiff straw and yellow grain. It is lower in test weight than Park and Rodney, but produces excellent yields under both dryland and irrigation. Cayuse was first released by Washington and Idaho, then later by Montana.

Rodney matures slightly later than Park. It is a tall oat characterized by large plump, white seed of high test weight. Rodney resists stem rust, smut and some crown rust.

Russell is a white oat with good test weight, straw strength and yield performance. It matures earlier than Rodney and Park, but later than Cody II. Russell lacks resistance to certain diseases.
