Two Row Feed Barley

Baronesse is a two row feed barley that has produced excellent yields and heavy test weights in both irrigated and dryland regions. Baronesse was originally P.V.P. German malt barley. Western Plant Breeders owns the production rights in the United States and is produced and distributed by its associate members.
