Variety Description

Targhee is expected to compete favorably with existing two-row spring varieties such as Hector in non-irrigated or dryland environments in Idaho and other western states. It is also expected to exhibit advantages over Hector in short season environments with limited irrigation, where the improved lodging resistance of Targhee vs. Hector would be an advantage. Targhee is a feed barley variety.

Pedigree

The two-row spring barley selection Targhee originated at Aberdeen as an F5 head row from the cross 60Ab1810-53/Hector. (The parent 60Ab1810-53 is one of 35 component lines of Klages.) It was developed cooperatively by USDA-ARS and the Idaho Agriculture Experiment Station.

Seed Class

Breeder and Foundation Class seed will be maintained by the Idaho Agricultural Experiment Station and the University of Idaho Foundations Seed Program. USDA/ARS will have no seed available for distribution. Foundation Seed should be requested through the producers own state Foundation Seed Program or Crop Improvement Association. Registered and certified classes of seed are available through certified seed dealers.
