Larker

Larker is a white-kerneled, semismooth-awned, six-row malting barley. It has moderate resistance to lodging, is high in test weight, and is about equal to Traill in height. Larker yields have averaged above Traill. It heads two or three days earlier than Traill. It is moderately susceptible to the smuts and powdery mildew and resistant to stem rust. It may have some tolerance to barley yellow dwarf virus.
