SW Midas

SW Midas is a medium seed size, early maturing yellow pea with improved powdery mildew resistance and excellent stand ability. SW Midas has an extremely durable seed coat – one of its greatest strengths. We would still caution growers, however, not to handle SW Midas with any less care than they would other varieties as internal damage to the seed can occur when handled too roughly. Nonetheless, when handled appropriately, SW Midas's uniform, smooth round seed makes it highly desirable to the food processing channels. SW Midas has outperformed most other popular varieties in the western and southern growing areas (SD, W ND, & MT) and has shown to be competitive in all other geographies.

Advantages

New variety, consistently high yield, very good disease and stand ability.

Adapted Area

This should be similar to INTEGRA and ADMIRAL. It will do best in the high yield areas or under no-till in the dryer areas. Treat the seed and seed early for highest yields.
