### DAWN

---

- ORIGIN Dawn was developed at the Panhandle Station and released by the Nebraska Experiment Station in 1976.
- MATURITY About 7 to 10 days earlier than Panhandle.
- DESCRIPTION Dawn is a short millet with a tight panicle. It ripens uniformly and is quite resistant to shattering and lodging compared to Panhandle. It has a large white seed and the grain is similar in appearance to Panhandle.
- ADAPTATION Dawn is adapted anywhere millet is grown. It may be direct harvested rather than swathed, because of its short stature and early maturity.
- SEED CLASSES Breeder, Foundation, Registered, Certified.
