## MILLET

DAWN

ORIGIN

Dawn was developed at the Panhandle Station and released by the Nebraska Experiment Station in 1976.

MATURITY

About 7 to 10 days earlier than Panhandle.

DESCRIPTION

Dawn is a short millet with a tight panicle. It ripens uniformly and is quite resistant to shattering and lodging compared to Panhandle. It has a large white seed and the grain is similar in appearance to Panhandle.

ADAPTATION

Dawn is adapted anywhere millet is grown. It may be direct harvested rather than swathed, because of its short stature and early maturity.
