

Description of PB1-97-WW-155-102

PB1-97-WW-155-102 is a common, soft white, winter wheat, *Triticum aestivum*. Leaves at booting blue green; first leaf at booting erect, twisted, waxy. First leaf below flag leaf wide, long, glabrous. Auricles white with 10% showing purple traces, glabrous, few hairs along auricle edge. Heading and anthesis mid season. Stem strong, waxy, four (4) above ground nodes, color at maturity white; internode hollow; last rachis internode edge pubescent. Anthers yellow. Height mid tall. Spike mid long to long, wide, mid dense, fusiform, awned, at maturity blond, inclined. Glume long, wide, at maturity blond; shoulder narrow, oblique; beak mid wide, medium short. Seed white/amber, mid long, mid wide, oval to ovate; bush size medium; bush length medium; collar small; cheeks rounded with 10% angular; crease narrow, mid deep; germ mid sized.

PB1-97-WW-155-102 is adapted to the soft white winter wheat growing areas of the Pacific Northwest. PB1-97-WW-155-102 is resistant to stripe rust, tolerant to Pythium. Plant Breeders I will provide as needed breeders seed derived from head hill increases. Foundation, registered and certified seed will be produced by cooperating seed companies.
