

LCS Genie is the first malting barley to be marketed under the LCS Brand. Bred by Limagrain Europe, it was rated satisfactory in pilot scale evaluations by the American Malt Barley Association and was given eligibility for Plant Scale Evaluation in 2014. With good levels of protein and extract, LCS Genie fits domestic and adjunct-style brewing operations and all malt craft brewers. LCS Genie is a spring, two-row barley with very high yields in Washington. LCS Genie was tested in the Washington State University barley trials in 2013-14 and is adapted to areas receiving 16" or greater precipitation. It is very early, one day earlier than Baronesse, and very short, four inches shorter than Baronesse. The stem collar is closed, and the neck is straight. Flag leaves are upright and waxy, the head is tapering, slightly waxy, and the rachis lacks hairs. The awns are very long, and the seed is covered with a slightly wrinkled hull. Plant Variety Protection will be applied for.
