23rd Joint Meeting of WSCIA/WNISA

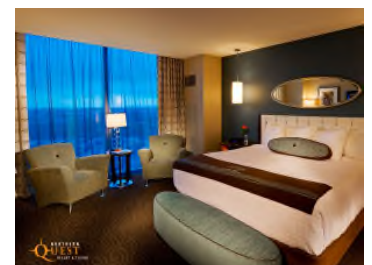
November 14th and 15th
