SPRING WHEAT VARIETIES

Fortuna is a solid stemmed, sawfly resistant hard red spring wheat developed in North Dakota. It is an early, beardless variety with good yielding qualities. Fortuna is resistant to prevalent races of leaf and stem rust.

Shortana is a semidwarf hard red spring wheat released jointly by Montana and ARS, USDA. It is resistant to loose smut and stem rust but is susceptible to leaf rust. Shortana has excellent straw strength.

Ward is an early maturing durum wheat that was released by North Dakota. It has good straw strength and leaf and stem rust resistance.

Wells is a durum wheat which has good straw strength and resistance to stem rust, leaf rust, bunt and loose smut. It is medium tall in plant height.
